Dear Parishioners,

The great Christmas is just around the corner sans festivities. We all love Christmas, and it brings families together, people together. All these wonderful things are going to be nostalgia or will take place on a limited way this year to protect ourselves and others.

Christmas we can imagine with our intellect and biblical insight as the gift of the Father. To put it in the words of the Evangelist John 3-16 "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son" reason, that we may have life and that too life in abundance.

In order to realize the plan of God, today's readings spell out through prophesies and angelic message God's initiative toward us. time slot, so that we can do it in an organized way, so that we can follow the government protocol. Just send us an email or give us a call and we will confirm the same.


Also, please, if you can, visit the church compound and enjoy the blue lights decorations and the Christmas manger set up by the Knight of Columbus.


