### Reading Reflection From One of our Own

## The Immaculate Conception. --- (by: Agustin G.)

The name of a young virgin woman of the town of Nazareth in Galilee was Mary. She was betrothed to a man named Joseph, also of the house of David, and in the line of the Messiah, the Savior, promised by God to Abraham. And before they lived together, God sent His angel Gabriel with a wonderful message, saying, "Hail, full of grace! The Lord is with you." She was greatly troubled, so, the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive a son whom you shall name Jesus. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give Him the throne of his father David, and He will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his Kingdom there will be no end." Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I have no relations with a man?" And the angel said, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore, the child to be born will be called the Son of God. And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God." Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. Be done onto me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her (cf. Lk 1: 26-38) God had chosen Mary to be the mother for His Son Jesus and preserved her from the stain of the original sin, to condition an immaculate womb for His Son. Thus, Mary was the first to receive the benefit of the redemption that her Son would merit for all. We celebrate in this opportunity the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, as well as the immaculate birth of His Son. The angel greets Mary glowingly, describing the event in messianic terms, calling Jesus, the "Son of God," for she conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit, and offered her a sign in the miraculous pregnancy of her elder
