Reading Reflection From One of our Own

The Kingdom of God is already here. --- (by: Agustin G.)

The Gospel of St. Mark says that John the Baptist was in the Jordan river baptizing people. That he called himself, "the voice in the wilderness sent to prepare the way of the Lord. "I baptize you with water, but one mightier than I comes, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose. He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire" (cf. Lk 3: 16) He also said that he wasn't the Messiah but Jesus, "the Lamb of God," whom James and John, two of his disciples, followed when they heard the Baptist saying that. Andrew and his brother Simon followed later. The Gospel of St. Mark mostly deals with the Baptism of Jesus and His temptation in the desert, then of His public ministry, which begins after the arrest of John the Baptist. His pronouncement was also a call to repentance, saying to the people, "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel." And His healings and forgiveness of sins are signs of the Kingdom of God that He announced. It was typical of the first-century rabbinical schools for students to seek out rabbis, and many ended up following Pharisees, but Jesus breaks with this tradition and invites His disciples to learn from Him. So, when Jesus walked by the shore of the Sea of Galilee and saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting their fishing nets into the sea, Jesus said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." They immediately abandoned their nets and followed Jesus (cf. Mk 1: 1420) Jesus was a person of action, with a magnetism in His personality that prompted the events to happen in rapid succession, so, the fishermen readily put aside their livelihood to become His followers when they heard Jesus that He will make them "fishers of men." They immediately followed Him. Then He walked along a little farther by the shore, and saw James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John, mending their nets and Jesus called them in the same way that He called Andrew and Simon. And they were also ready, and immediately left their father Zebedee in the boat along with the hired men and followed Him.
