Some women went to embalm Jesus, but they found the stone rolled back, no soldiers and the tomb empty; and an angel told them that Jesus was alive. Peter and John knew it and went out to the tomb, saw, and believed (cf. Mk 16: 1-7) Only God could have done it! (cf. Jn 20: 31) That evening, doors locked, Jesus came in, not as spirit but in bodily form. His disciples touched the marks of His Crucifixion, and even gave Him something to eat. "Peace," Jesus told them. "As the Father sent me, so I send you. Receive the Holy Spirit. The sins you forgive are forgiven, and the sins you retain are retained." In another apparition, Jesus said to Thomas, "Put your finger in my hands, and your hand into my side, and believe." Thomas said, "My Lord and my God!" and Jesus said, "Blessed those who believe without seeing." Then said to all, "I had told you before that everything written about me should be fulfilled. That I must suffer, die, and resurrect on the third day. You are witnesses." (cf. Lk 24: 44) Jesus, the Son of God, God Himself, did it.
